- ② Wild Basin, County Rd. 84
off Hwy. 7.
*Kinglets, Black Swift,
many mountain birds.*
- ③ Indian Peaks Wilderness
*Pine Grosbeak, Amer. Pipit,
Hermit Thrush, warblers,
ptarmigan.*
- ④ Betasso Preserve on
Betasso Rd. off Sugar-
loaf Rd.
*Bluebirds, Red Crossbill,
nuthatches, Plumbeous Vireo.*
- ⑤ Walker Ranch on
Flagstaff Rd.
*Bluebird trail, Williamson's
Sapsucker, flycatchers, Blue
Grouse.*
- ⑥ Eldorado Canyon
State Park.
*Prairie Falcon, Canyon Wren,
hummingbirds, Golden Eagle.*
- ⑦ Doudy Draw/S. Mesa Trail
on 170 W. of Hwy. 93
*Lazuli Bunting, Bullock's
Oriole, towhees, Black-headed
Grosbeak, Virginia's Warbler,
Western Scrub-Jay.*
- ⑧ Sage Trail off Hwy. 36 E
on Longhorn Rd.
*Lark Sparrow, Blue Grosbeak,
Sage Thrasher, kingbirds,
raptors.*
- ⑨ Boulder Res. on 51st,
N. of Jay Rd.
*N. Harrier, Bald Eagle, gulls, water-
fowl, grebes, grassland sparrows.*
- ⑩ Walden/Sawhill Ponds W. of
75th, N. of Valmont Rd.
*Best birding location in
county, great for wide variety
of water and land birds.*
- ⑪ White Rocks Trail N. of
Valmont, W. of 95th St.
*Raptors, waterfowl, owls,
egrets, herons, songbirds.*
- ⑫ Golden Ponds W. of
Hover on 3rd St.
*Best in Spring,
songbirds, waterfowl.*
- ⑬ Jim Hamm Park, Union Res.,
17th Ave. at County Line Rd.
Shorebirds, grebes, pelicans, eagles.
- ⑭ Rabbit Mtn., 53rd St. N.
of Hwy. 66
*Gnatcatcher, raptors, sparrows,
bluebirds.*
